Volunteer Opportunity Descriptions

All volunteers choose their shifts. Needs are sent out to the volunteers, and individuals choose whether or not to sign up for that particular need. By marking your interests you are indicating what opportunities you want to hear about.

- Museum Docent:** Guide tours of the museum and Tower in Sturgeon Bay to pre-scheduled groups. Groups may sign up any time during the year, but all docent-led tours are booked in advance.
- Tug Docent:** Guide tours of the historic tug *John Purves*. Docents sign up for half-day or full-day shifts to lead two or four tours at set times each day. Tours are offered seven days per week, May 1-October 31.
- Cana Island Tractor Driver:** Drive a John Deere tractor towing a wooden haywagon across the causeway, bringing visitors to and from the Cana Island Lighthouse. Cana Island is open May 1-October 31.
- Cana Island Docent:** Share historic information about the Cana Island Lighthouse, keeper's quarters, and out buildings. Cana Island is open May 1-October 31.
- Field Trip Docent:** Work with the museum's Education department to lead school groups on tours of the museum and Tower in Sturgeon Bay. Must be comfortable and willing to work with kids of all ages. Tours will be scheduled in advance and can occur anytime during the school year.
- Education Strike Team:** Be our first call for help with education programs, and work with the Education Programs Manager to facilitate programming. Activities can include robotics, science activities, nature walks, day camps, and more.
- SPARK! Program Aide:** Assist DCMM and other cultural organizations in Door County with presentations aimed at individuals with memory care issues and their caregivers. Programs are the third Wednesday of the month 10am-12pm, March-December
- Tower Docent:** Work at the highest point in Door County! Stationed at the top of the Jim Kress Maritime Lighthouse Tower, answer questions regarding the views and local highlights. During busy times help keep traffic moving by reminding visitors of the other things to see in the Tower.
- Classic & Wooden Boat Show:** Assist with the event, held in early August. There are many opportunities at the event, including working food & beer tent, assisting people on and off boats for rides, working the Boathouse Sale, and helping with the Sikaflex boat build challenge.
- Lighthouse Festival:** Answer questions and provide parking and walking directions at some of the historic Door County lighthouses. Lighthouse Festivals are held in June and October.
- Baking for Jingle Mixer:** Share your favorite cookie, bar, or other holiday treat! Bakers make 2-3 dozen of their favorite recipe that are then served at the Jingle Mixer in mid-December.
- Boat Raffle Sales:** Sell raffle tickets for the wooden boat built by the Boat Building class. Sales events are at several of the summer and autumn festivals throughout Door County.
- Family Day with Santa:** Help with traffic control, information, and family activities on a Saturday in November when Santa visits the museum.
- Jingle Mixer:** Our annual holiday party! There are many volunteer opportunities at this event, including greeting/coat check, assisting with live auctions, raffle ticket sales, and food service.
- Office Work:** Assist with filing, data entry, and other office tasks.
- Archival Work:** Assist the Curatorial department with cataloging, scanning, or other work on our collections and archives.
- Carpentry/Woodworking:** Assist with building displays, reorganizing exhibits, or building tools for educational programming.
